1. Is it insufficient to read the Bible only for the purpose of discovering new information? Has this ever led to boredom in your life? Why?
2. Is it insufficient to read the Bible only for the purpose of finding tips for a better life? Has this ever led to frustration in your life? Why?
3. Another way to read the Bible is to focus on the gospel: (1) Who is God? (2) What is man? (3) How can sinful man be reconciled to a holy God? Paul repeatedly answers these questions in Acts. As a group, recount some of his responses.
4. Why is Gospel-centered Bible reading more fulfilling than reading for self-improvement or to satisfy intellectual curiosity?
