1. Paul appears to have had no difficulty being re-directed by God (16:6-10). How do you know when God is leading? What fears do you have about following God's leading?
2. In Acts 16:17 the girl who had a spirit of divination said, "These men are slaves of the most high god, who proclaim to you a way of salvation." (my translation) Why would Paul become very angry over this?
3. Paul & Silas sang in prison after being beaten. How is that possible? Is there any evidence of the effect that had on other prisoners or the jailor?
4. This is a chapter that highlights both evangelism and discipleship. What part are fulfilling in both of these areas?
