

### Questions for reflection: Colossians 3:1-11

1. Where are you tempted to find your identity? What you do (e. g. job)? Your position (e.g. parent)? A past worth boasting about or from which to hide?
2. What does it mean that your life is “hidden with Christ in God”? (v. 3) How does that affect your understanding of your identity?
3. What are the “things above” on which we are to set our minds? How can you actively and continually set your mind on things above (vv. 1-2)?
4. How is covetousness idolatry? (v. 5) Is covetousness really so bad that it should be included in a list w/ sexual immorality and evil desires?
5. How are you being continually “renewed in knowledge” (v. 10) after the image of your Creator? What does that look like day to day?
