

## Questions for reflection – Acts 6

1. What gifts and abilities do you have that can be used in serving in one or more ministries in the church? Are you using them? Can someone retire from serving in the church?
2. Why should it matter that those chosen to oversee the distribution of care to the poor be “full of the Spirit” and “wise” (6:3)? Why not look, for example, for those who are compassionate & kind?
3. In light of 6:3, should spiritual maturity be any more / less important for someone working in a soup kitchen than for an elder of the church? Why? Why not?
4. Has anyone ever lied to get you in trouble? How did you respond? How should you respond if someone were to bear false witness against you?
