2. What does the story of Simon the magician tell us about conversion? Is it enough to believe the gospel? How can a believer have assurance of salvation?
3. How would you answer the eunuch's question in v. 34? To put it another way, if you were in Philip's place in v. 35, what would you say?
4. Have you taken up the challenge of specifically praying regularly for one or two unbelievers you know? How have you made progress in having gospel conversation with them?
