

Questions for reflection – Acts 7

1. How did Stephen's sermon address the accusations against him (cf. 6:11, 13-14)? In other words, why did he choose to draw attention to the particular points he highlights?
2. Are Stephen's accusers guilty of the very charge they bring against him? If so, how? If not, why not?
3. What, if anything, from Stephen's life do you wish were characteristic of yours? How might you attain what you see lacking in yourself?
4. Spend some time in prayer, asking God to strengthen your faith, increase your spiritual wisdom & understanding and take away any fear of engaging others in gospel conversations.
5. Also, do you have one or two people for whom you are praying regularly that they might be saved? Ask your small group to keep you accountable both to pray for them and to pursue gospel conversations with them.
