

Questions for reflection – Acts 19

1. In 19:1-11, we discover people who received the Holy Spirit and began to speak in tongues and prophesy. Should we take from this passage that this is normal Christian experience? (Be sure to think through other conversions throughout Acts.)
2. Is it possible to believe what is true about Jesus, but not be saved? How can you have assurance that you are saved?
3. Why, in verse 17, was the “name of the Lord extolled”? Why should exorcists being beaten by a demon-possessed man result in the fear of the Lord falling on unbelievers?
4. Has living your faith led to disturbances in the circumstances around you? Is that inevitable? How have you dealt with such difficulty?
