

Questions for reflection: 1 Thessalonians 3:9-13

1. What gives you joy? What does Paul identify as a source of joy in this letter to the Thessalonians? What is the relationship between our source of joy and how we pray?
2. How has thanksgiving for God's grace in the lives of others overflowed from your prayers?
3. Are you praying for Christ Baptist in a way that requires your involvement? What is it?
4. Commit to praying for someone you don't currently pray for and ask a friend to hold you accountable. Then, after consistently praying for that person, tell them you have been praying for them, ask them how you can pray more specifically, and continue to pray for them.
